Around ovulation, the cervix is soft (like your ear lobe), slightly open and may be positioned high up in your abdomen. Hi, my cervix was soft and shortened to a 2 at 29 weeks. Oxytocin, along with other hormones, stimulates ripening of the cervix leading to successive dilation during labour.
